

Making a simple lavender centerpiece

1. Start with a base. An example of this might be a tray, a piece of wood, or fabric. I like to use a long charcuterie board.
2. Pick your vase(s) or container(s). I can be one or multiple containers. (Keep in mind that odd numbers of items are more pleasing to the eye) I used three vases for this centerpiece
3. Fill the container(s) with dried lavender bundles.
4. After you place the vase(s) on the base, you can then add a greenery of your choice.
5. Add whatever seasonal decorations you like amidst the greenery. For fall, I used pumpkins.
